We are pleased to announce that the 10th Brain Tumor Meeting will take place at the Max Delbrück Center für Molecular Medicine (MDC) in Berlin (Germany) on May 23 - 24, 2019. In summer 2000 Berlin neuroscientists, neurosurgeons and neurologists focusing on brain tumors initiated this scientific conference series. It was repeated in 2001, 2004, 2006, 2008, 2011, 2013, 2015, and 2017 - throughout this time the Brain Tumor Meeting gained national and international attention and attracted many leading scientist working on brain tumors. The main focus of the meeting is to provide a platform for an interdisciplinary scientific exchange especially between scientists and clinicians.
